## A Ten Day Journey of a Lifetime

My senior class went on our 10 day cross country trip September 13-23. We started in Spokane and flew to Oregon, California (including, San Francisco, LA, Catalina Island), Nevada, Grand Canyon, Utah, Idaho and home again. I must say it was one of the best trips I have ever embarked on in my life. A few videos and many pictures have been posted to our website already, and many more will come when I have time to edit them. I got to do an IFR departure out of Roseburg, Oregon. The clouds were

1000 ft above the airport so we flew into them; it was one of the most amazing experiences I have ever encountered. At about 4200 feet we broke out of the clouds as I was turning into the morning Sun. It was breathtaking!

My next favorite event was flying out to Catalina Island, 20 miles off the coast of Los Angeles. The whole island was covered in clouds other than the airport, tucked on a hillside next to some 1600 ft mountains and cliffs. We had lunch there and I bought some souvenirs for Dawn and the kids.

Over the weekend we stayed in Salt Lake City at our instructor's parents house. A group of the students and my instructor decided that we wanted to go and tour the Mormon Temple. I have to say that they have some amazing art and depictions of various aspects of biblical history. We ended up getting

a tour by 2 Mormon girls. After some introductions they shared aspects of their faith. We asked questions and politely shared what we believe. Someone asked if Abeyta knew that she was going to be saved and she said she wasn't sure. The Holy Spirit brought 1 John 5:13 to mind. I shared it with her and then the Holy Spirit came on me in power and I began to preach the Gospel to her! It was so exciting, she listened intently and seemed very interested. However, as I began to share more the other girl noticed and quickly interrupted and changed the subject. ### Ministry Updates

*We still are feeling God's leading toward high school ministry and aviation. This desire began for me when I was 16 years old. I was struggling with how hard high school was. The darkness that existed, the complete lack of direction I felt, and the various other struggles that teenagers go through. It was then that God first burdened me for high school students. Most teenagers have these deep needs that they often can't express and so they seek to meet them in sex, partying, and flat out rebellion. There is no vision in their lives and so they expend them with what they have been introduced to. I have found that most of them are hungry for the Gospel and have simply not been shown it in a powerful way. The second desire God has given, which He began to place in me from childhood, is a love for aviation. When I felt a strong calling to the ministry at 22, I was also taken up in an airplane to go flying. I had not flown for 5 years and forgot how much I loved it. I wrestled in prayer for weeks between what I thought was a selfish fleshly desire and the desire to serve God in ministry. One day in prayer God did some supernatural things and it was then that I realized that He wanted me to use aviation for ministry as a key part of spreading the Gospel in high schools. Satan has had control of the public school system long enough and it is time to begin taking back ground for the Kingdom of God! I have already seen doors opened for this type of ministry and am fully convinced that as we step out in faith, He will continue to present opportunities for the Gospel to be shared more in high schools.*

If you are weary, I understand, because I have often been there during this journey; but don't give up because you will eventually begin to see a beautiful harvest from your labors.
